

HOSTING A REENTRY LIFE SIMULATION

A Reentry Life Simulation is an **experiential learning opportunity** designed to help participants understand the day-to-day struggles of reentry.

DURING THE SIMULATION

Participants assume a role and complete tasks at simulated agencies. They endure “real life” struggles and participate in debrief & group discussion.

PURPOSE

- **Educate** on collateral consequences of criminal records
- **Sensitize** to the realities of difficult situations
- **Understand** real issues and barriers to self-sufficiency
- **Recognize** how factors shape behavior and beliefs
- **Reduce stigma**, bias and cultural stereotypes
- **Motivate** participants to become involved

KEY POINTS TO CONSIDER

- The entire simulation lasts 2.5 hours with additional 2 hours needed for simulation set up.
- All planning, marketing & training materials will be provided.
- The host agency will coordinate registration and recruitment of participants and volunteers. They will need 60-80 participants & 10+ volunteers confirmed at least 2 weeks prior to event.
- The host agency will provide a large, gymnasium-sized room for the event.
- **A fee of \$800 (plus mileage outside Franklin County) is required.** This is a labor-intensive training. It requires more than 50 hours of staff time per simulation, plus travel time and cost of material printing, as well as replacement costs for missing or damaged prop items.
